- The exchange rate to be used for the calculation of local production and content must be the exchange rate published by the South African Reserve Bank (SARB) at 12:00 on the date of advertisement of the bid.
- Only the South African Bureau of Standards (SABS) approved technical specification number SATS 1286:2011 must be used to calculate local content.
- The local content (LC) expressed as a percentage of the bid price must be calculated in accordance with the following formula:  $LC = (1 - x/y) * 100$  Where X is the imported content in Rand Y is the bid price in Rand excluding value added tax (VAT) Prices referred to in the determination of x must be converted to Rand (ZAR) by using the exchange rate published by the SARB at 12:00 on the date of advertisement of the bid. The Declaration Certificate for Local Production and Content (MBD 6.2) together with the Annex C (Local Content declaration: summary schedule) must be completed, duly signed and submitted by the bidder at the closing date and NO SIZES QUANTITY The rates of exchange quoted by the bidder in paragraph 4.1 of the Declaration Certificate will be verified for accuracy.
