## **Specifications.**

### **Bunker Jacket:**

- The bunker jacket must meet NFPA ( National Fire Protection Association) 1974 standard
- 3 layers with Aqua tec & Q 9 material.
- Radio pouch to be provided with closing flap with Velcro strap.
- Yellow lyme reflective tape to be provided on the arms and waist as specified in NFPA.
- Waist length or bunny style with two front pockets.
- Elbow and shoulder padding or protective material to be provided on the bunker jacket.

### **Bunker Trouser**

- The bunker trouser must meet NFPA ( National Fire Protection Association) 1974 standard
- 3 layers with Aqua tec & Q 9 material
- Yellow lyme reflective tape to be provided below the knees as specified in NFPA
- Pockets to be provided on the bunker pants
- Knee padding or protective material to be provided for the bunker trousers

- Durable suspender straps to be provided with clips for loosening and attacking

### **Structural Fire Fighting Boots**

- Fire fighting boots to meet NFPA standard.
- Boots not to of a leather type

### **Fire Fighting Helmet**

- Fire fighting helmet to meet NFPA standard
- Must have chin straps and NFPA approved visor.

### **Fire fighting gloves**

- Structural fire fighting gloves must meet NFPA Standard
- Must be durable and have three layers.

### **Flash hood / Balaclava**

- P 84 balaclava to meet NFPA standard
